Ways you can help at home: Maths

In Maths we will revisit our learning of shapes. Learn that some shapes are **2D shapes** and some are **3D shapes**.

Can the children use the correct vocabulary?

2D shapes, flat, square, rectangle, triangle, circle.

3D shapes, solid, cube, cuboid, sphere, cylinder, pyramid, cone.

And learn the properties of the 3D shapes.

Faces, point, corner, side, edge, curved, straight, round.

We will also revisit **repeated patterns**; can you create your own repeated pattern? Can you continue the repeated pattern?

This week in preparation for the **King's Coronation**, the children will draw a picture of themselves as a King or Queen. More information to follow soon.
