Ways you can help at home: Maths.

This week in maths we will recap our prior learning - finding **one more and one less**.

We will say the number that is **one more and one less than a given number**. e.g. 6 is one less than 7 and 8 is one more than 7.

At home,

Can you practice at home? Give your child some biscuits. How many would you have if I give you one more? What is one more than 5? How many would you have if I ate one and there was one less? So one less than 7 is ?
