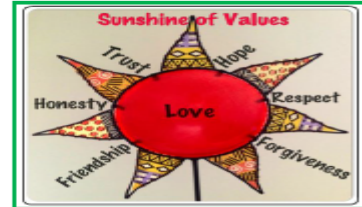

What Is Yom Kippur?



Yom Kippur is the holiest day of the year for Jewish people. It takes place on the tenth day of the Jewish month of Tishri (September or October).

Jewish people believe that on this day, Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the Ten Commandments.

The Ten Commandments taught the Israelites about **forgiveness** and how to live in the best way.

Now, this day is remembered each year as Yom Kippur.



Forgiveness is deciding not to pay someone back when they hurt you. Instead you let go of your anger and move on.
