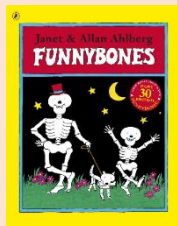




Dear Parents/Carers

Our Book of the week:

This week we will enjoy listening to the story **Funny Bones**. We will encourage the children to join in with repetitive parts of the story and ask them to retell the story in the correct sequence. We will try to use the correct conjunctions **first, next, then, finally** to retell the story.



We will ask the children to recall what happened at the beginning, in the middle and at the end of the story.

The children will also have an opportunity to retell the story in our 'Funny Bones' small world area.



Vocabulary this week:

Talk time - Each week we learn new words in class and talk about the meaning of the words. The words we will be focusing on are: **skeleton, house, dark, bones**. We will look at 'Cyril the skeleton' in class and learn to use the words...

Skull, spine, hip, wrist, knee, thigh, elbow, joints, ribs, shoulder blade...

Maybe you could talk about these words at home and try to use them in your conversations.

Ways you can help at home:

Mathematics - Maths this week we will be learning to find subitise and represent 1, 2 and 3. We will be looking at making groups of different amounts, identifying how many items are in a group without counting and drawing different amounts of objects using a numeral to help us.

We will be representing these on a five frame.



What can I do at home?
