World Book Day is approaching and we would like to invite your child to join us in celebrating with us, as a school, on **Friday 8th March**. The theme of the day for 2024 is '**Read Your Way**' and we are looking forward to celebrating this with different planned activities throughout the day.

The children are invited to come to school dressed as their favourite book character or in any way they feel comfortable when reading – pj's, oodie, joggers...however they can 'Read Their Own Way'! (Please do remember that the children will still be outside at playtime and lunchtime so clothing and footwear must be suitable for them to play outside safely)

The fun will start with a special World Book Day assembly and then the children will have the opportunity to take part in a range of activities planned by their class teacher. There will be a special competition running in KS1 and KS2 and the opportunity to apply for a Blue Peter book badge.

We would love it if the children could come with their favourite book, or they are welcome to use their library reader from school...there may be a special challenge for them involving reading.

As in previous years, the children will receive a voucher allowing them to buy one of the special £1 titles released for World Book Day.
