

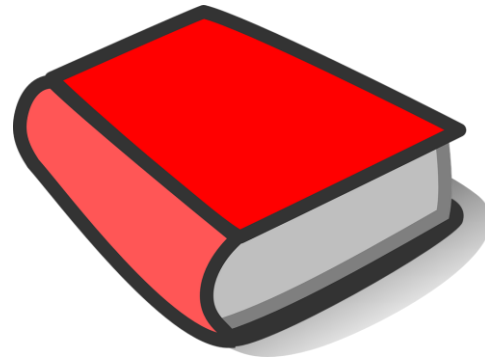

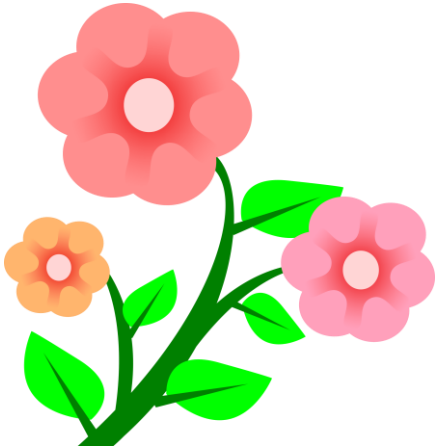
Sparkle team

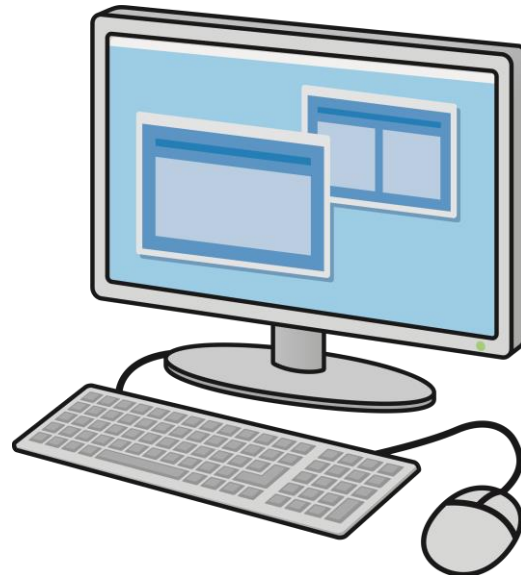
Shine Team

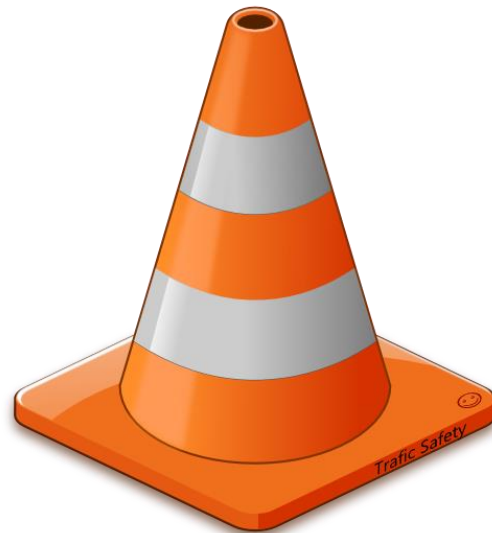
Digital Leaders
