Safeguarding corner

Top tips for encouraging open conversations at home from National On-Line Safety.

1. **Create a safe space.** Criticism, blaming or shaming can all prevent children from feeling emotionally safe – while showing affection, positive attention and an interest in what a child has to say builds their sense of security. These formative years are when children's opinions and views begin to take shape, so it's important to provide a non-judgmental environment in which to discuss them - especially if their opinions differ from yours.
2. **Normalise chats about feelings.** Incorporate mental health and emotional well-being into everyday conversation, using age appropriate language and examples to help children understand their emotions. Ask questions such as "What was the best part of your day?" Is there anything you want to talk about?

Holidays in term time

Holidays must not be taken during term time as this has an extremely detrimental effect on your child's education.

The long term cost to your child's education of going on holiday in term time, far outweighs the short term gain of the holiday at the time. The £60 fixed penalty notice is the least of the costs; it is the impact on your child's future educational success that presents the greatest cost. Children miss vital learning that cannot be repeated. It is widely acknowledged that mental health and personal well-being flourish when children have good routines and engage with their learning. Holidays in term time are disruptive on both counts. **I urge you to prioritise the long term benefits of regular school attendance, over the short term impact of a holiday in term time.**
